In continuation to the Ministry's letter of even No. dated 16.01.2015 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the college with respect to the proposal submitted to the Central Government as cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the CCIM in terms of the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant regulations made thereunder and approved norms for academic session 2015-16, which were circulated vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/01/2015-EP (IM-1) dated 05.05.2015 (available on Ministry's website <indianmedicine.nic.in>); permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to **Shri Jagadguru Gavisiddeshwar Sansthan, Ayurvedic Medical College, Post Graduate Studies & Research Centre, Gavimath Campus, Koppal, Karnataka** to increase the admission capacity from 50 to 60 seats (10 additional seats) in existing UG (BAMS) course, from the academic session 2015-16 under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970.
